The Cost of Attendance (COA) is an estimate of the cost of attending RVU and maintaining a modest but adequate standard of living. Your individual budget may be higher or lower. The COA does not include living expenses for a student's spouse or other dependents. Total loan amounts borrowed and scholarships awarded cannot exceed the COA minus any other aid received.

Loan fees represent the estimated amount an average student would pay if they borrow from the Federal Direct Loan program.

Students are strongly encouraged to complete a personal budget and only borrow the minimum amount needed to cover their actual costs. Many RVUCOM students are able to live on less than the COA by budgeting carefully and reducing their expenses for room, board, personal and transportation costs.
