

Reserving OMM Table Study Space to practice clinical skills

Effective November 14 to November 25

Phase Blue permits the use of the study rooms for students via a reservation system. This process has been successfully implemented using the online SRSS (CO) and BORRS (UT) at each campus.

Labs spaces on both campuses will be converted to “Study Spaces” for after hour and weekend access to OMM tables to practice for upcoming competency exams. This allows interested students the opportunity to practice hands-on skills in a safe, controlled environment on campus.

Details are as follows:

1. Every other table in the lab will be designated as a study space for reserved use to maximize distance between study partners.
2. Only two students are allowed per table and both students must be from their previously assigned lab groups.
3. Tables in the lab study spaces will be numerically marked.
4. Tables in the lab study spaces must be reserved through the BORRS and SRSS process just like reserving any other on campus study space.
5. Table study spaces may be reserved in 2 hour blocks as follows:
 - Monday – Friday from 6:30 PM – 8:30 PM
 - Saturday (UT) from 8:00 AM – 8:00 PM
 - Sunday (CO) from 8:00 AM – 8:00 PM
 - * Students should vacate the lab after 1:50 minutes to allow the next couple to enter and clean the table.
6. Students will check in at the security desk and will be confirmed that they are in the same lab group.
7. Students must complete the Screening and Attestation, get temperature taken, wear surgical masks, practice vigilant hand hygiene, **and** must wear eye goggles in the lab study spaces.
8. Safety Officers will make random checks on the labs at regular frequencies to enforce safety compliance. Violations will result in appropriate consequences.
9. Students are required to thoroughly clean the table before use and after use. Disinfectant supplies will be provided.
