Authorship

- Do you have the agreement from all authors who have contributed to the care or write-up of the case?
- Do you have agreement from your institution to publish this case? *Please see "The Right to Write: Who 'Owns' the Case Report?"*
- Are author affiliations relevant to where the patient received treatment?
- Are there author conflicts of interest relevant to the drug treatment or devices used in the management of the patient?

Consent

- Please use the latest BMJ consent form. For children, those with diminished capacity or deceased patients, please write the name and relation of the signatory on the consent form. *Further information can be found here: <https://authors.bmj.com/policies/patient-consent-and-confidentiality/>*
- We will require a separate consent form for every individual whose medical information is included in the case report, even if they are not the main patient.
- Is this patient part of a wider research study?
- Has this case been presented at a conference? *If so, please add this to the acknowledgements section upon submission.*
- Has this case been submitted to or published in another journal? *You will be asked to confirm that the manuscript has been submitted solely to this journal and is not published, in press, or submitted elsewhere.*
- Is there a pre-print version of this case already in existence? *Please note BMJ will not accept case reports which have been previously submitted to a preprint server due to patient confidentiality reasons.*

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- Please remove the exact age
- Is the exact occupation necessary, is it clinically relevant?
- Is the ethnic origin of the patient necessary, is it clinically relevant?
- Please remove any detail that alludes to the precise location of the patient
- Please remove the name of your institution from the text of the manuscript
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- Has this case been submitted elsewhere? *Submission to a BMJ journal implies that the work described has not been accepted for publication elsewhere, that it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere and does not duplicate material already published.*
