The Cost of Attendance (COA) is an estimate of the cost of attending RVU and maintaining a modest but adequate standard of living. Your individual budget may be higher or lower. Books and supplies cost includes an OMS I \$300 OMM table and \$35 iClicker; OMS II \$35 iClicker. Also included in OMS II & III is an additional \$1,000 for board prep material. The COA does not include living expenses for a student's spouse or other dependents. Total loan amounts borrowed, and scholarships awarded cannot exceed the COA minus any other aid received.
