<sup>3</sup> The Cost of Attendance varies by year in school and is updated annually.

The Cost of Attendance (COA) is an estimate of the cost of attending RVU and maintaining a modest but adequate standard of living. Your individual budget may be higher or lower. Books and supplies costs have been equally split between all semesters for the academic award year. The COA does not include living expenses for a student's spouse or other dependents. Total loan amounts borrowed, and outside scholarships awarded cannot exceed the COA. This COA is on a Borrower-Based Aid Year (BBAY 2) model. The program is currently not eligible for Title IV funding.

Many RVU students are able to live on less than the COA by budgeting carefully and reducing their expenses for food and housing, personal and transportation costs.
