¹ Summer semester will be billed for \$10,300 and Fall semester will be billed for \$20,600. Financial Aid Loans will be split between both semesters equally. Please budget accordingly.

² Student Health Insurance is pending approval by the state. This amount includes the entire policy charge of \$5,936 plus a pro-rated charge of \$947 for coverage dates ranging from 6/2/25 – 7/31/25.

³The Cost of Attendance varies by year in school and is updated annually.

The Cost of Attendance (COA) is an estimate of the cost of attending RVU and maintaining a modest but adequate standard of living. The COA does not include living expenses for a student's spouse or other dependents. Total loan amounts borrowed, and outside scholarships awarded cannot exceed the COA. Books and supplies costs have been equally split between all semesters for the academic award year. This COA is on a Borrower-Based Aid Year (BBAY 1) model. The program is currently not eligible for Title IV funding.
