The Cost of Attendance (COA) is an estimate of the cost of attending RVU and maintaining a modest but adequate standard of living. Your individual budget may be higher or lower. The COA does not include living expenses for a student's spouse or other dependents. Total loan amounts borrowed, and scholarships awarded cannot exceed the COA minus any other aid received. Non-applicable (N/A) fees are not associated with the summer term.

Students are strongly encouraged to complete a personal budget and only borrow the minimum amount needed to cover their actual costs. Many RVU students are able to live on less than the COA by budgeting carefully and reducing their expenses for food and housing, personal and transportation costs.
